4. LESSONS LEARNED FROM COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Surveys.
 During the Outreach Workshops, the Day One team implemented a survey to help understand community viewpoints and needs. The survey included open-ended questions aimed at understanding the spaces best fit for Master Plan projects. It also asked about flooding, concerns related to water, and attempted to understand water priorities. The surveys are only one method of data collection and, while not exhaustive, they do allow an opportunity to begin a discussion with the residents. All data collected through surveys will be shared with CMC. Inputting the data electronically will allow CWA to easily download the answers and understand community priorities.

Community Priorities Identified.
 The primary reason for conducting outreach is to understand community needs and concerns. Doing so requires engaging a diverse set of residents and having a strong understanding of the environmental history of El Monte. On the following page, we list and describe (in no particular order) our key findings learned through our engagement. The hope is that some of this feedback can be incorporated into the Master Plan. As will become clear, residents see the Master Plan as an opportunity to increase green spaces in the City while increasing community health.

Date Conducted: 27 April 2024
Number of Engagements: 58
Number of Surveys: 33

Description: Hosted yearly, the Wellness Festival attracts a significant number of residents, particularly parents with children in the El Monte City School District. The event utilized a "passport" system where attendees visit every booth at the event to learn about their services. This allowed us to engage a significant number of community members. The focus of this event was environmental programming. During the event, we shared information about the Master Plan, sparked conversations, and collected community input.
